

Inter University Gliding League Rules

About

The Inter University Gliding League is a competition run throughout the year (1st September – 31st August), and allows the various university gliding clubs to compete against each other to determine the overall best university gliding club for the year.

How to Compete

The league is based on a points system with points being awarded in several categories. The three categories are;

- Recruitment
- Progression
- Cross Country. These will be explained in more detail below.

How do you enter?

University gliding clubs must register by the 31st September for the upcoming year. Once registered points can then start to be accumulated. Each club should appoint a Inter University Gliding League Steward who will be responsible for submitting their clubs points.

How are points obtained?

Submission of points

All points to be counted in the league must be submitted to the league. Points will only be legal if the university gliding club has registered for the league. Points must be claimed inside 'league time'. League time begins on the 1st September and runs up until the 31st August. Anything obtained before this years league time is not valid for this year's league.

All achievements will be worth their full points values for 2 months after they were obtained. After that time the points are halved. After a further 2 months the points are quartered. Submit points early and often!

N.B. Any cheating discovered will have the consequence of the cheating University being removed from the league for the year.

Sending Points

Photocopies of relevant logbooks, signed badge claim forms and licences will be accepted as proof of qualifications, as will scanned images. Please submit claims via email including attachments to league@interunisleague.co.uk including all relevant details
